



WHITE CROSS WALKERS COMPO'S CRAWL P.T. 93—10 Km.



THIS TRAIL IS VALID until 31/12/2012

START: Library & Tourist Information Centre, Woodhead Road, Holmfirth, W. Yorkshire

CAR PARKING: Adjacent to Tourist Information Centre (Pay & Display)

GRADE: 2+ (PLEASE BE AWARE THAT ROUTE IS QUITE STRENUOUS. (Total ascent 298 m.)

PLEASE NOTE: The organisers are not responsible for accidents, thefts and/or damage to property. Every effort will be made by the organisers to make this a safe, enjoyable and memorable trail.

Route Description: (Last revised 13/07/2011)

- 1 Leave the Library & Tourist Information Centre and turn right. Take the first left turn (No entry signs) and cross the bridge. (Norah Batty's house, with the iron steps, is to your right). Go ahead up the steep path to the left of the Elephant & Castle P. H. and at end of path turn right uphill, passing well on right, to reach the road.
Question 1: What is the carved inscription on the well?
- 2 Turn right on the road for 0.8 Km. Continue past the cemetery on your right to reach a barn on your right (in process of conversion to a house)
Question 2: What is the date above the barn door?
- 3 Retrace your steps for 5 metres and turn right through metal gate opposite the barn corner and go up track. Pass between derelict buildings (signs advertising restoration) and continue to track junction. Turn right on track to reach road at a junction. Go ahead on Cartworth Moor Road for 0.8 Km passing a cricket pitch to your right and a football pitch to your left.
Question 3: What is the name of the football club printed on the sign on the building end?
- 4 When road becomes a track continue ahead for 1 Km. to reach the road. Cross road to track and go ahead for 1.1 Km. passing trees to your left, to reach sharp left hand bend (with seat). Leave track to go ahead through small gate and continue on footpath between walls. Go through kissing gate and follow right hand wall, bending right, for approx. 30 metres to reach a track junction. Turn sharply left downhill on track to reach another track junction.
- 5 Turn left on track, initially with wall on right. When track becomes a path continue to stile on right. Cross stile and immediately fork right on path with gully to your left. Go ahead on path, soon with stream on right, passing a picnic area on your left to reach a T-junction with a track. Turn left passing between gateposts to reach road and reservoir. Turn R and go down road for 1.1 Km initially with reservoir on left. After double bend take right fork, Dobb Top Road, and go ahead to shortly pass the imposing walled entrance and double gates of house No 35.
Question 4: What is the name of house No. 35?
- 6 When you reach the road junction, continue on Dobb Top Road which swings down into a dip, bends sharply left and begins to ascend the other side. At next road junction turn left and follow Dobb Lane downhill. Cross bridge over river and continue on road, now with houses on left.
