COMPO's CRAWL

P.T. 93—10 Km.



START: Tourist Information Centre and Library, Woodhead Road, Holmfirth, W. Yorkshire

Route Description: (Last revision 30/06/2008)

- 1 Leave the Tourist Information Centre/Library and turn right. At the bookshop turn left and cross the bridge. (Nora Batty's house, with the iron steps, to your right). Go ahead up the steep path to the left of the Elephant & Castle P. H. and at end of path turn right uphill to the road.

Question 1: What is the name of the cottage on the left (opposite the well)?

- 2 Turn right on road (Cemetery Road) for 0.8 Km. Continue past the cemetery on your right to reach a barn on your right (in process of conversion to house)

Question 2: What is the date above the barn door?

- 3 Retrace your steps for 5 metres and turn right through metal gate opposite the barn corner and go up track. Pass between buildings and continue to track junction. Turn right on track to reach road at a junction. Go ahead on Cartworth Moor Road for 0.8 Km passing several farms.

Question 3: What is the name of the last farm on the right, just before the road becomes a track?

- 4 When road becomes a track continue ahead for 1 Km. to reach the road. Cross road to track and go ahead for 1.1 Km. passing trees to your left, to reach sharp left hand bend (with seat). Leave track to go ahead through small gate and continue on footpath between walls. Go through kissing gate and follow right hand wall, bending right, for approx. 10 metres to reach a track junction. Turn sharply left downhill on track to reach another track junction.

- 5 Turn left on track, initially with wall on right. When track becomes a path continue to stile on right. Cross stile and immediately fork right on path with gully to your left. Go ahead on path, soon with stream on right, passing a picnic area on your left to reach road and reservoir.

- 6 Turn R and go down road for 1.1 Km initially with reservoir on left. After double bend take right fork, Dobb Top Road, and continue to junction. Stay on Dobb Top Road which swings down into a dip, bends sharply left and begins to ascend the other side. At next road junction turn left and follow Dobb Lane downhill. **Question 4: What is the name of the last bungalow on left side of road?**

- 7 Pass small mill dam on your right, cross bridge and continue on road, now with houses on left. Take first right turn, at footpath sign high up on pole, into Water Street (no name board but opposite Old Road)
