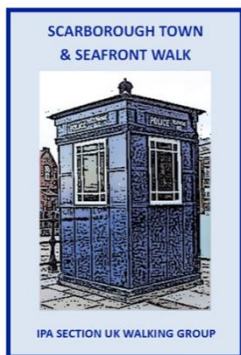
## Walking Weekend

Accommodation is not being arranged centrally but a list of suggested venues will be provided so everyone can book their own preferred style.



Transport: Railway Station at Scarborough served by trains from York and Hull. There is no direct train link to Whitby. There is an hourly bus service between Scarborough & Whitby via Robin Hoods Bay. We will consider option to car share for those arriving by public transport and should numbers require, arrange large taxis for the Saturday trip to Whitby.

Costs are £1.50 per walk per person (print/bring your own route description) plus £2.50 if you would like a cloth badge (Scarborough only). A free Souvenir Log Book sticker will also be available for both walks.
